IMPLEMENTATION SCHEDULE FOR CURRICULUM AND RELATED ACTIVITIES

(2011–2012)

Elementary, Junior High and Senior High

The Implementation Schedule is a long-term planning tool to assist school authorities in planning resource allocations, and in developing and implementing professional learning activities. These include participation in Ministry activities related to curriculum (programs of study, assessment tools, learning and teaching resources) development, and implementing new/revised curriculum. The schedule provides optional and provincial implementation dates, revised provincial assessments, distributed learning materials, and proposed learning and teaching resources availability. The degree of change for each subject area is indicated using a star rating system (see bottom of each subject-area page) to facilitate planning and professional development activities. The schedule is based on a September 1 to August 31 school year.

This year, the Implementation Schedule includes new information on *Action on Curriculum: Curriculum Standards and Process Redesign*. *Action on Curriculum* reflects Alberta Education's commitment to continually improve its work in providing a world-class, student-centred curriculum for students now and in the future.

The goals of *Action on Curriculum* are to develop:

- revised standards and guidelines for future curriculum (programs of study, assessment tools, and learning and teaching resources)
- revised processes for curriculum development.

Programs of study, assessment tools, and learning and teaching resources that are developed using the revised principles, standards and guidelines of *Action on Curriculum* are indicated in this Implementation Schedule by the **coloured shading**.
