OVERVIEW OF PROGRAMS OF STUDY

DEFINITIONS OF PROGRAMS

- **Nine-year Program**

Alberta Education is assisting school authorities to successfully implement the nine-year provincial language and culture programs of study with a Grade 4 entry point.

The German Language and Culture Nine-year Program (Grade 4 to Grade 12) is intended for students who are beginning their study of German language and culture in elementary school.

- **Six-year Program**

The German Language and Culture Six-year Program (Grades 7–8–9, 10-6Y, 20-6Y, 30-6Y) is intended for students who are beginning their study of German language and culture in junior high school.

- **Three-year Program**

The German Language and Culture Three-year Program (10-3Y, 20-3Y, 30-3Y) is intended for students who are beginning their study of German language and culture in senior high school.

THE CONCEPTUAL MODEL

The aim of the German language and culture programs of study is the development of communicative competence in German.

Four Components

For the purposes of the program of studies, communicative competence is represented by four interrelated and interdependent components.

Applications deal with what the students will be able to do with the language, the functions they will be able to perform and the contexts in which they will be able to operate.





Language Competence addresses the students' knowledge of the language and their ability to use that knowledge to interpret and produce meaningful texts appropriate to the situations in which they are used.

Strategies help students learn and communicate more effectively and more efficiently.

Global Citizenship aims to develop intercultural competence, with a particular focus on Chinese culture.



Annotation:

This resource is suitable for the first or intermediate years of German language learning. It begins with the conjugation of sein and progresses through topics such as present tense, negation, accusative and dative, past tense, subordinate clauses and future tense. The concepts become progressively more advanced through the text. The material is grammar-based and the text is black and white; there are few graphics and no photographs. Instructions and discussion are in English. The answer key and progress checks include keys to all the exercises in the Arbeitsheft, as well as two cumulative progress checks and their keys.

Comments:

- Due to its grammar orientation, it is most suitable as support material for grammar concepts and practice in the classroom.

This video series offers numerous strategies and activities that teachers can use when teaching second languages. The narrations and discussions are in English while the demonstrations are in various languages. The strategies can be adapted to other second language teaching activities.

The resource offers a close examination of assessment in second language high school classrooms. Three case studies feature second language teachers using various assessment methods; e.g., the Integrated Performance Assessment Model, Performance Tasks and Backward Design. Each case study follows a teacher as she works through the process, from setting clear goals, giving directions and modelling, to giving immediate and helpful feedback to students on their performance.

Interviews with district assessment leaders and teachers convey the importance of identifying learning outcomes, designing engaging activities and providing specific and timely feedback to students. All are essential in building language proficiency in second language classrooms.

Demonstrations of teaching, learning and the assessment process are conducted in French, Spanish or English. Activities are student-centred and assessment-driven but are also interesting and fun. Comments from students reflect the success of these three case studies. They share how the teaching and learning activities motivated them to practise and improve throughout the course.

Annotation:

This resource presents Clara, a native of Germany, and the activities she engages in with her family and friends. Clara shares with viewers that elementary school in Germany is a half-day program. In the DVD, she tells about her after-school activities, such as completing homework, taking horseback riding lessons, watching football (soccer) on television and playing games with her family. She shows the viewers how she and her friends prepare for a play that they later perform for their families. The narration is in English but the conversations among the characters are in German. The story portrays a strong sense of independence and creativity. Teachers could encourage students to compare their activities with Clara's as shown in the video.

This video series offers numerous strategies and activities that teachers can use when teaching second languages. The narrations and discussions are in English while the demonstrations are in various languages. The strategies can be adapted to other second language teaching activities.

Communicating about Sports presents ideas and strategies, in Chinese, that teachers can use when teaching sports-related material to a class of Grade 6 second language students. Students work on various activities to practise using sports vocabulary; e.g., using a Venn diagram to compare what sports Chinese and Americans enjoy playing, interviewing a classmate about his or her sport-related likes and dislikes, role-playing. Students also practise writing Chinese characters in class, as homework and in an ongoing activity where they compose and send a letter to a pen pal in China.

In this resource, a teacher demonstrates her understanding of learner outcomes and how she incorporates them in her lessons. She uses total physical response (TPR) to involve students in acting out and saying sports vocabulary. She uses facial expressions and gestures to help students understand the terms. Small-group and large-group activities allow students opportunities to work with one or more of their classmates. Students comment on the importance of engaging activities that encouraged them to learn and practise the language.

This video series offers numerous strategies and activities that teachers can use when teaching second languages. The narrations and discussions are in English while the demonstrations are in various languages. The strategies can be adapted to other second language teaching activities.

In this resource, a teacher walks the viewer through a typical lesson with a Grade 5 Japanese class. The video is useful to any teacher instructing in a second language classroom. It provides practical ideas and strategies, e.g., total physical response (TPR), modeling, paired practice and student-led charades, for vocabulary instruction.

In the video, students engage in activities; e.g., creating a personal daily routine, using filmstrip boxes. The routine is then shared with a partner who presents the daily routine to the class. In another activity, a Venn diagram is used to compare Japanese and American culture.

The video makes reference to language applications and cultural comparisons that coincide with curricular objectives found in the language and culture programs of study. Student perspectives, on the benefits of learning a second language, are also provided.

The booklet and CD consist of five fairy tales—*Tausend Spiegel* (East Indian), *Das Glückskind* (Brothers Grimm), *Der Pechvogel* (Turkестanian), *Hans im Glück* (Brothers Grimm) and *Das Schlafende Glück* (Persian)—varying in length from 4 to 10 minutes. There is also an interview with storyteller Frau Gerndt. Each of these topics has a written text that paraphrases the CD texts. Follow-up activities are provided in the booklet, with instructions written in German. The level of the activities is progressively more difficult; i.e., from simple comprehension and labelling to analysis and synthesis. There are also three bonus tracks of live versions of *Tausend Spiegel*, *Der Pechvogel* and *Das Schlafende Glück*. Specific grammar concepts covered are present perfect, conjunctive and comparatives.

Annotation:

Das neue Deutschmobil 1 – Lehrwerk für Kinder is a comprehensive resource package that addresses the outcomes of the program of studies for grades 4 and 5. It consists of a student textbook; a student workbook; audio materials (on either CD or audiocassette) containing texts and dialogues, listening comprehension exercises and songs; a teacher resource manual; a test booklet; and a vocabulary booklet. The progression of skill development in the student text is appropriate for beginning learners. The material is presented in a clean and appealing manner and is logical in its progression; the pacing is appropriate. Colourful graphics and photos support text. This is an excellent resource for young learners beginning their study of German. The student workbook contains engaging and varied activities and many black-and-white illustrations. The *Wörterheft* contains word lists that accompany the student text. The CD (70 minutes in length) accompanies the student text and contains listening activities, dialogues and songs to promote listening comprehension. Enunciation is clear and instructions are easy to follow. The *Testheft* (Test Booklet) contains tasks that assess reading comprehension and written production. The tasks consist of fill-in-the-blank exercises, sentence completions with or without provided vocabulary, and true–false items. Tasks that assess listening comprehension and oral production are not provided. Although the tasks generally lack a communicative context, the *Testheft* is a helpful resource. The teacher's resource manual (*Lehrerhandbuch*) contains an answer key, audio transcripts, games and activities as well as assessment material.

Comments:

- Tasks to assess listening comprehension and oral production need to be developed by the teacher.

Cautions:

- The textbook occasionally shows illustrations of a friendly, childlike witch.

This resource contains ten chapters that each include a grammatical concept, often embedded within a theme: *Kinder aus vielen Ländern begrüßen sich* (cases, *Einwohner* suffixes); *Bandwurmwürmer kriechen nicht* (compound words); *Verstecken, suchen, finden* (2-way prepositions); *Für alle Fälle Fälle* (cases); *Kapitel 5* (possessive pronouns); *Kapitel 6* (adjective endings); *zum Zirkus und Zoo* (strong verbs); *Wird die Treppe gespült?* (passive); *Kapitel 9* (separable prefix verbs); *Kapitel 10* (cases). The materials are suitable for use at a beginner's level (i.e., songs using repetition and replacement similar to "Old MacDonald") or advanced levels (i.e., effect of cases on the word order of pronouns, "Wem leihst du deinen Kuli?"). Each chapter consists of 2–3 pages of suggestions for instruction followed by 4–7 pages of blackline masters of worksheets for student use in the classroom. The instructional materials are in German.

Comments:

- The recordings of the songs are by a children's chorus, and may be of limited appeal to students of some ages.

Exploring German (3rd Edition) is well organized and user-friendly, using several methods of instructional delivery and providing students with the opportunity to evaluate their German language skills.

The textbook is colourful and current. It uses English to acquaint students with cultural information and for instructions. This makes the book particularly useful for students who are learning German, but whose main language environment is English. A variety of strategies are used to encourage language acquisition and correct use. One of these is SYMTALK (symbols and talk), which uses symbols in the place of words written on a board to provide visual learners with exercises that will involve them further in learning German. Authentic references are also present in a section of each unit entitled “*lebende Sprache* (living language).”

The workbook is a collection of black-and-white worksheets that correspond to the material covered in the textbook. A large number of activities and games ensure a broad appeal to various learning styles and, again, the instructions are given in English to facilitate student understanding.

The teacher’s guide provides teachers with ideas of how to introduce each unit and with model unit plans. It also takes into consideration that the resource might be used for differing amounts of time and makes suggestions as to which units to cover in either a 3-, 6- or 9-week or semester course. All the symbols required for SYMTALK are provided, followed by the textbook and workbook answer keys. The audio CD program manager follows, clearly detailing which track to play where and the duration of each track. The scripts for all audio tracks are included. A check-up section concludes the guide, covering four of the language competencies. They can be used as quizzes or tests, or as a self-evaluation tool for the student. Answer keys as well as a CD track guide are provided and are clearly laid out.

The colorful overhead transparencies, organized in a binder, have two versions of the same picture—one that is labeled and one that is not. They can be used in numerous ways (e.g., labeling in class, start for a conversation, as a quiz) to aid student understanding of the concepts covered in the textbook. The transparencies are easy to locate.

Included are numerous flash cards organized in the following topics: Questions, People, Clothes, Transportation, Time/Days of the Week, Weather, Verbs, Sports/Entertainment/News, Objects/Other Nouns, Places, Other Parts of Speech, Foods, Colours, Prepositions/Connecting Words and Adjectives/Adverbs. Each card contains a symbol that replaces the word(s) that have been covered by the textbook. They can be used to practice vocabulary or to construct sentences (SYMTALK). Each card has a magnet and may be used in conjunction with a whiteboard. The cards are not only labeled (small font in the corner) in German, but also in French, Spanish and Italian. This way the flash cards may be shared with language teaching colleagues.

Comments:

- This resource is best suited to a German as a second language (GSL) environment. It relies on English to provide students with cultural information and instructions.

This video series offers numerous strategies and activities that teachers can use when teaching second languages. The narrations and discussions are in English while the demonstrations are in various languages. The strategies can be adapted to other second language teaching activities.

This resource demonstrates the teaching of Chinese in a multilevel class (Levels 2, 3 and 4), using a theme-based approach. In the video, the teacher leads students in an exploration of directions, both literally and metaphorically.

First, Level 2 and 3 students work in small groups to learn how to get to a Chinese restaurant. They use simple maps they have created to facilitate questions and answers, including finding directions and providing descriptions of neighbourhood buildings and services.

The guide also contains copy masters for assessment. *Pingpong Neu* promotes communication and active learning. It includes games, songs and group work as well as learning strategies. *Pingpong Neu 2* is the second level in a three-level series.

The CD-ROM images throughout the student textbook indicate the location of the text on the CD-ROMs. The third audio CD-ROM consists of pronunciation practices. These CD-ROMs provide students ample opportunities to listen to the German language and improve their pronunciation.

The black-and-white teacher's resource manual is written in German and includes tips for teaching, reproducible tests and answer keys for the textbook and workbook.

The teacher's guide is in German and provides transcripts of audio texts, answers to exercises in the textbook and workbook, ideas for delivery of the material, and tests and quizzes for the individual units along with the answers for the same.

The two CDs come with a printed guide that identifies to which lesson and section in the textbook each track corresponds. The CDs relate to material in the textbook only, not the workbook. The language on the CDs is conversational and the students are intended to decode and synthesize information from this natural conversation. For this reason, Planet 3 is best suited to a bilingual program.

Comments:

- Best use is for bilingual programs due to the nature of audio and to grammar topics.


