- 4. You will need one Statutory Declaration Form for **each** original translation of a document that you have been requested to provide or that you wish to submit in support of your application for teaching authority.
- 5. Two signatures are required on the form. The Notary Public or Commissioner for Oaths is to sign on the lower left side, below the date. The blank line to the right is intended for the translator's signature.
- 6. If you do not currently reside in the province of Alberta, but live in Canada, and will be submitting a statutory declaration, please provide the attached statutory declaration form to the Commissioner for Oaths or Notary Public where you reside to use as a template.
- 7. If you currently reside outside Canada and will be submitting a statutory declaration, please provide the attached statutory declaration form **to a Notary Public** where you reside to use as a template.
