221	Francophone Education Program	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - registered in a Francophone school offering French first-language programming (FR) governed by a Francophone Regional authority - at least one parent is a right holder under section 23 of the <i>Canadian Charter of Rights and Freedoms</i> - language of daily instruction is French for all courses except for English Language Arts (ELA) which is taught in English - takes Français course (FRA)
211	Alternative French Language Program	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - registered in a school offering Alternative French programming (AF) - typically enrolled in a French Immersion program - majority of course subjects are taught daily in French - takes French Language Arts course (FLA)
230	French as a Second Language Course	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - registered in a school offering regular programming and offering French as a Second Language (FL) courses - language of daily instruction is English - takes a French as a Second Language (FSL) course

Notes:

- A student may only be designated with **one** of the above codes: 221, 211 or 230
- A student may not be assigned two or three of these codes simultaneously
