COLLABORATION AND SYSTEM SUPPORTS

The Collaboration and System Supports Branch promotes collaboration among First Nations, Métis and Inuit communities, provincial school authorities and other key education stakeholders by providing provincial standards, programs and Accountability Pillar implementation services.

The branch provides support to school authorities and education partners on matters related to First Nations, Métis and Inuit education and culture, and promotes evidence-based decision-making to enhance student success.

- Build capacity and collaboration among schools, school authorities and communities to identify and implement proven practices to help eliminate the achievement gap among First Nations, Métis and Inuit students
- Support provincial school jurisdiction three-year education plans and accountability reporting, including improving education outcomes for First Nations, Métis and Inuit students and the delivery of First Nations, Métis and Inuit education for all students
- Ensure support for, and development of, collaborative plans between provincial school jurisdictions and First Nations and Métis communities
